
## Notice of Changes to o2cm


Effective April 15, 2019, all competitors wishing to register online for competitions via o2cm, will be required to have a Registrant Identification Number (RIN). RINs are permanent and unique identifiers designed to link competitors' complete compendia of personal identification numbers issued by various DanceSport sanctioning bodies (USA Dance, WDSF, CDS, CDF, AAU, etc.). This update was executed in order to streamline the registration process for competition organizers, to enhance current features of o2cm and to improve overall user experience. Added benefits include improved results searches, enhanced live.o2cm, reduced duplication of competitors within the app and quick and easy access to world leader boards.

## How do I get my RIN?

- Visit the o2cm Competitor's Portal at competitor.o2cm.com.
- Click on the REGISTER NOW button at the top left-hand side of the page.




- The REGISTER page will open
- Create your **Competitor Account** by filling in all the fields. *NOTE: In the field labeled Associated Account\* enter the username/email address associated with the o2cm Registration Account you use to log in when registering for competitions. This may be your email address or the email address of your parent, spouse, partner or a dance studio or team administrator.*




• Click the **REGISTER** button at the bottom right-hand side of the page to register your **Competitor Account** and generate your RIN. The **MANAGE** page will open.

## How do I manage my Competitor Account?


- Once you register your account and your RIN is generated, the **MANAGE** page will open.
- Click the SELECT button next to your name to expand the Competitor Details window.




- Confirm your personal information.
  - 1. Be sure to enter your correct birth year.
  - 2. Be sure to enter the username email associated with the o2cm Registration Account used to register for competitions in the field labeled "Account Ref." This may be your own email address or it may the email address of a parent, spouse, partner or a dance studio or team administrator. SPECIAL NOTE: If you used the same email to set up both your Registration Account and Competitor Account, there is no need to fill in this field.
  - 3. Be sure to enter the membership identification numbers for the various sanctioning organizations of which you are a member and click the **VALIDATE** buttons for verification.




NOTE: You may also generate RINs for other dancers in your family (siblings, children, spouse) with the same last name. This is especially helpful for parents of juniors, brothersister partners and married couple partners. Enter the first name of the competitor you would like to add to your account.



• The box at the top of the **MANAGE** page will contain a list of all the competitors and their RIN's under your Competitors Account. Click the **SELECT** button next to each competitor's name.



Repeat steps 1 – 3 outlined above for each competitor under your account.



## What happens next?

Once you have your individual RIN, you may register for competitions via o2cm. The registration process has not changed.

It is important to understand that you now have o2cm accounts; the new Competitor Account you created to generate your RIN and the original Registration Account you created to register for competitions with the o2cm registration app. Your Competitor Account and Registration Account are linked, but they are two independent accounts. Your log in credentials (username/email and password) may be the same for both accounts or they may be different. It depends on what you established when creating each account. This can be a little confusing so if you established a unique set of log in credentials for each account, be sure to use the appropriate credentials when logging into each account. You may also change your Competitor Account password by visiting the MANAGE page in your Competitor's Portal and clicking on UPDATE PASSWORD.
